CITY COUNCIL, SOUTH SHORES, MAIN CLUB... WHAT'S NEXT?

The Friday before the city council was scheduled to meet for an open session to entertain comments from the public regarding the proposed move for the San Diego Mission Bay Boat & Ski Club to the South Shores location, I received a phone call from the City Real Estate Assets Department. Since the meeting was due to take place the following Monday, I immediately sent e-mail messages advising interested parties. After printing flyers detailing the open session, I posted them on our dock and placed some on the bar at the main club, instructing the bartender to notify everyone.

Monday, November 18, 2002, I attended the meeting along with four others associated with the main club, Tony Williams, the commodore, Mitch Burner their paid lobbyist, Glen Gentile, Convair Ski Club, and member of the moving committee, and Peter Wilson head of the Athletic Association. They were all made aware of the meeting from my flyers left at the club.

When the agenda item on the docket came up Mitch spoke first, followed by Tony. Their very brief comments were unremarkable; Mitch took the negative approach of blaming the Council for putting the SDMBBSC in this predicament then insisted that they vote to move forward immediately. Tony spoke for less than one minute, simply stating who he was and then urged the council to move forward. Glen Gentile spoke in favor and gave an interesting overview of what the Convair Ski Club is all about, providing low cost water-skiing/wakeboarding to the community and is part of the main club in need of a facility that is not land locked. Judith Moore, wife of Steve Levon, president of the Athletic Association, wrote an excellent presentation read by Peter Wilson, in favor of the move.

The closed session was scheduled for the following day, Tuesday, November 19, but was bumped to the next week due to a full agenda. The matter will trail each week until the Council hears all of the legal matters on their docket first. I will keep you informed on the progress.
