**During the June general meeting, 12 members discussed & decided on a few very important Ski Team issues.**

**A unanimous vote** was taken to have signs made & installed in Hidden Anchorage. They will be placed two at the dock, and 2 on the breakwater. Ordering will be done this week. It's still not too late to give me your input, especially with the wording. I have been working with the city's department of Parks & Recreation to place signs on the beach, and with the lifeguards to replace our channel markers. The Lifeguard office has recently notified me that they DO NOT have the money to replace our channel markers. At our next meeting, I will have information on approved markers that our Ski Team can purchase for the channel.

**The motion that was made** the previous month, and published in the last newsletter, to limit all slalom rides to 12 or 15 minutes was voted down. Everyone agreed that the current ruling is fine, **AS LONG AS**, each skier does not take an excessive amount of time during his/her set. It is imperative to be ready **before** the skier in front of you is finished with his/her turn. While skiing, be expedient, come in after 3 falls or 6 passes. Trick, wakeboard, or other turns are limited to **10 minutes**. Keep track of your time. Jumpers get four (4) attempts. Use your common sense and be courteous.

**AJ Hubner volunteered** to plan and

organize the very popular Rock the Dock parties this summer. I'll let you know as soon as I hear when the first one is planned.

**A representative from** the San Diego State Ski Team made a presentation and request to continue blocking off the permit calendar one alternating day a week for training. After stating that all three team boats and at least 15 students will be utilizing the course each week, the members in attendance all agreed. In return, the teams will maintain the course.
