It is that time of year. "At the regular meeting held in **November**, those at the meeting shall nominate a slate of officers. The motion to nominate requires a second. The election of officers will take place at the December meeting. Officers shall be elected and installed at the December meeting to serve for a one year term or until their successors are elected beginning January 1st. & ending December 31."

**The President** shall preside at all club and Executive Board meetings; appoint the standing committee heads immediately after installation; appoint special committees; sign with the treasurer, all checks over \$500; serve as ex officio member of all committees except the nomination committee.

The president shall not be required to pay admission to competition tournaments or clinics.

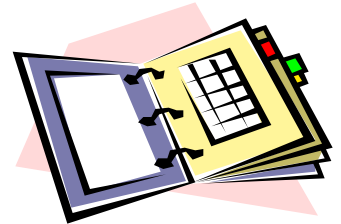
**The Vice president** shall assume the duties of the president in his / her absence; automatically become president in the case of death or resignation of the president; and serve as program chairman.

**The Secretary** shall record all proceedings of the meetings and executive board; handle all correspondence.

**The Treasurer** shall collect all dues and care for the club's funds; keep an accurate record of receipts and payments; submit a financial report at each executive board meeting; submit a financial report at each regular membership meeting; and an annual report at the January meeting.

## Mike Suyderhoud, Ron Goodrich & Correct Craft Invade Hidden Anchorage

**O**n Saturday, November 5, seventeen skiers attended the advanced slalom clinic taught by Mike Suyderhoud at Hidden Anchorage. Ian Morton of M2O Marine Outfitters provided us with a brand new, blue & white, 2006, Ski Nautique 196 for our slalom & trick skiing pleasure.

How fortunate we were to be on the receiving end of the most advanced slalom techniques taught today by one of the most respected coaches in the industry. Being able to ski behind the brand new redesigned Ski Nautique 196, driven by Ron Goodrich, was certainly a treat for us all.

While launching the new boat, I jokingly asked Ian how long we have to ski. His reply was, "Well love, a tank of gas will run skiers non-stop for 7 hours, I guess we'll have to quit then." That's exactly what we did, pulled 23 rides along with a dozen timing passes & start dock towing. One hour before an empty tank, an

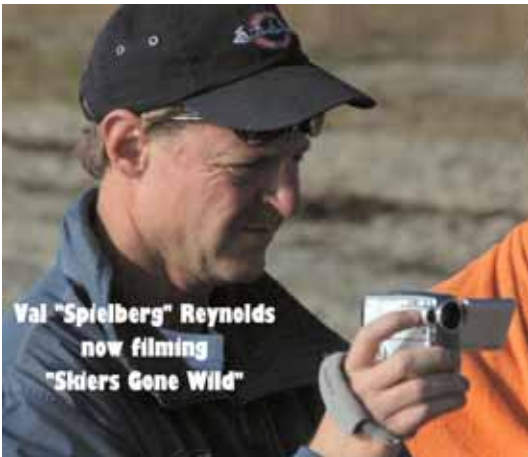


alarm beeped alerting the driver that a countdown had started. At that time, we had 2 skiers to go, so it worked out perfectly; it was already 2:30 PM. The water went from glass with that typical high tide bounce back, to a slight breeze that provided the sandpaper effect. It never blew out and remained skiable all day.

Attendance included skiers with a wide range of ability levels, from extreme shortline to trying all 6 buoys in a row. Mike had something to help everyone. The morning started with 25 minutes of dry land coaching. Mike explained what his 'West Coast style' is all about and how each skier can implement it. Then we took to the water.

Each set was a full 6 passes with a drop and coaching at each end. He even answered my questions & explained in depth what he wanted me to do during my set. I went away with that 'one thing' I





have been needing for so long. I honestly feel this is my ticket to better skiing.

Video reporter, Sonyman Val Reynolds, documented the morning, getting Mike and Ron's lecture along with the skiers on DVD. I know he'll be at the next meeting with the results. Thank you Val.



I was most impressed by the special treatment and individualized coaching Scott Leason received from both Mike and Ron. They have experience coaching the blind. Many of you know Scott from the blind ski program. He was blinded in a convenience store robbery.



Mike's hands-on, dry-land with Scott helped him tremendously. Scott's goal is to compete in the Disabled Worlds & his appreciation for this opportunity was most apparent. Suddenly, it became evident to me that the tremendous amount of time & effort I spent to make this morning a success was well worth it.

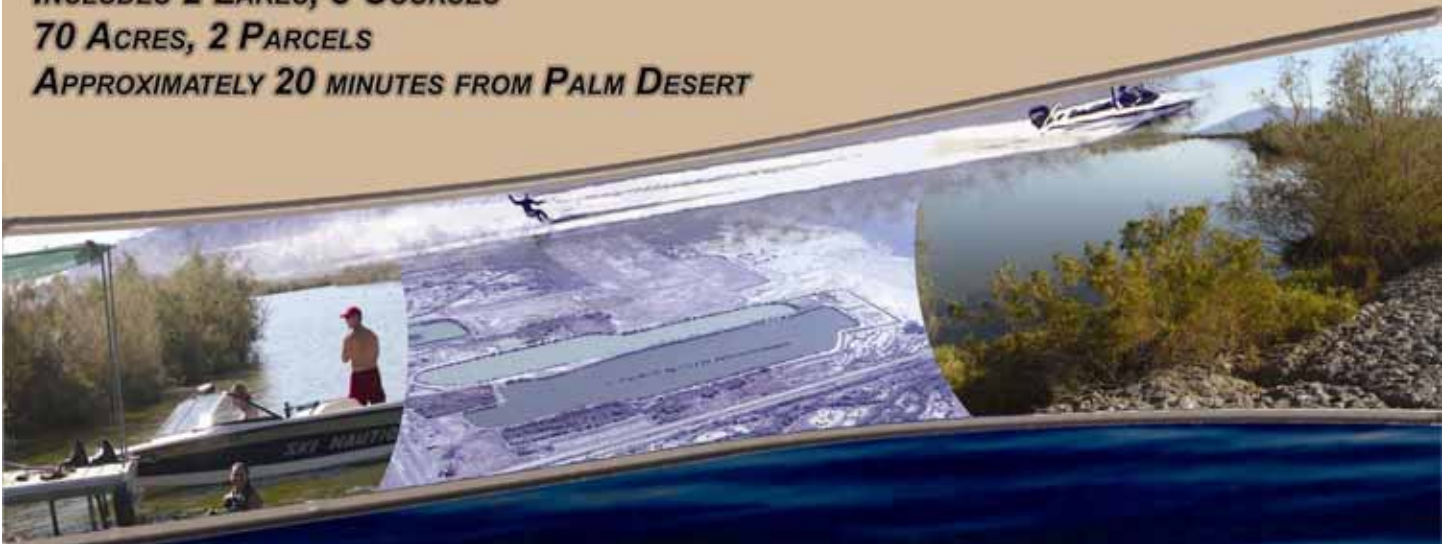
